The exhibition will run from Tuesday June 13 to Saturday July 15, 2017. The opening reception will be on Friday June 16, from 7pm-9pm.

ARTISTS WILL DROP OFF THEIR WORK ON SUNDAY JUNE 11, 9am-11am.

ARTISTS WILL PICK UP THEIR WORK ON SATURDAY JULY 13, 4-5pm.

Artists who are members in good standing of either Smithers Art Gallery or the BV Museum will be paid 75% of the sale price from any work. Artists who are non-members will be paid 65% of the sale price. Commissions owed to the Artist will be paid within 30 days of the close of the exhibition.

The Gallery will accept ONE work of art from each artist.

The Artist is responsible for delivering their artwork in "ready to hang" condition – this means medium-appropriate framing, if necessary, and hanging wire installed..

Artwork will be displayed in either the Gallery or the Museum, at the discretion of the installation committee.

During the period of the exhibition the Gallery maintains exclusive rights to the sale of the artwork. The Artist, or any agent on behalf of the Artist, may not sell, reserve, or remove the art which is in possession of the Gallery until after the duration of the exhibition.

The Gallery carries insurance for artwork that is on its premises during the exhibition timeframe. If any damage is done to artwork while on Gallery premises the Artist must make a claim, in writing, to the Gallery within 10 business days so that the Gallery can make its claim within the 30-day deadline. The Artist will be entitled to, and reimbursed for, the full amount recovered from the insurance company. The Gallery is not responsible for damage, theft, or other mishandlings that may occur during shipping to and from the Gallery.
